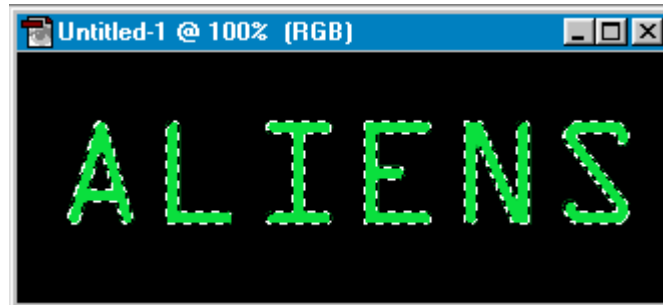


1. Create a new RGB image to work with. The example is 325x125, Resolution 72, and has a black background.
2. Choose a **Bright Green** color as your foreground and **Black** for your background color.
3. Choose **Edit -> Fill -> Background Color** to fill the background layer with black.
4. Select the **Type Tool** and choose the **Type Mask Tool** from the Options bar at the top of your screen (in earlier versions, drag to the right on the Type Tool icon). Next click inside the document and type any text you want (*choose any font or size you like*). Click the *Check mark* in the Options bar to finalize the text layer (*OK* in older versions).
5. Choose **Edit-> Fill-> Foreground Color** (the **green**).



6. Go to **Select-> Feather 2 pixels**
7. Choose **Filter-> Blur-> Radial Blur (100, Zoom, Best)**
8. Without deselecting, repeat step # 7. (Press **CTRL+F**)



9. Now, **Select-> Inverse** and repeat step # 7 again... **Filter-> Blur-> Radial Blur (100, Zoom, Best)**
