

1. Create a new image. I used 500x500

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2. Choose a color. I chose blue. On one of the colors, pick a light version. The other, a dark version. Go to Filter->Render->Clouds



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3. Add a new layer. Choose color white, and go to the gradient tool. Choose Foreground to Transparent, Pin Light, and 100% opacity.

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4. Start clicking! hold the house button down, and create about 1cm or less of a line. Continue, but in different spots. You can try to make them look like they come from one point by pointing them all to one side, or corner.



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5. Go to Layer->Layer Style->Bevel and Emboss.

Use these settings:

Style: Inner Bevel

Technique: Chisel Hard

Depth: 1000%

Direction: Up

Size: 180 px

Soften: 0 px

Angle: 120

Check Global Light

Altitude: 30

Gloss Contour: Linear

Un-Check Anti-Aliased

Highlight Mode: Pin Light (with a light version of your first chose color)

Opacity: 75%

Shadow Mode: Soft Light (with the same color as you just chose)
Opacity 100%

Then, apply



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6. Set layer style to overlay

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7. Duplicate layer

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8. Repeat step 5, but with these settings (on duplicated layer; new one)

Style: Outer Bevel

Technique: Chisel Hard

Depth: 1000%
Direction: Up
Size: 180 px
Soften: 0 px
Angle: 120
Check Global Light
Altitude: 30
Gloss Contour: Linear
Un-Check Anti-Aliased
Highlight Mode: Pin Light (with a light versoin of your first chose color)
Opacity: 75%
Shadow Mode: Soft Light (with the same color as you just chose)
Opacity 100%
(basically all the same exept style)
